SUBJECT – SIX-WEEK INTENSIVE SHORT COURSE ON UMA ZHIGYA PA (BODHISATTAVA DEEDS)

The Namgyal Institute of Tibetology will be conducting a six-week intensive short term course in English on UMA ZHIGYA PA (BODHISATTAVA DEEDS) by Dr. Jigme Losal with effect from 7th January, 2019 to 16th February, 2019.

All interested candidates who are registered college students or graduates in any discipline may submit their application to the Joint Director, Namgyal Institute of Tibetology on or before 17th December, 2018 paying the requisite registration fee of Rs.700/-. The application must be accompanied by authentic documents to prove their qualifications for the course. Online application will also be accepted subject to submission of scanned copies of their qualification certificates and on payment of registration fee in the office of the Joint Director prior to taking admission. This is also open to devotees and other individuals who are interested in the course and have the requisite qualification to attend the classes.

Uma Zhigya pa deals mainly with Bodhisattava deeds on virtuous practices. The literal meaning of Uma is middle and as the book contains 400 stanzas it is referred to as Uma Zhigyapa. The main contents of the text concerns abandonment of belief in permanence, pleasure, cleanliness etc.
