ADMISSION ANNOUNCEMENT FOR M.A COURSE IN BUDDHIST STUDIES (ENGLISH MEDIUM)

The Namgyal Institute of Tibetology was established under a Charter of Incorporation as Sikkim Research Institute of Tibetology on 1st October, 1958 by the then Maharaj Kumar Palden Thondup Namgyal, as a repository for Buddhist arts, arte facts, texts and scriptures. Since its establishment it has made valuable contribution in the field of research and preservation/conservation especially in the area of Buddhist studies, local culture and Himalayan tradition.

Starting from this academic year beginning July, 2019 the Namgyal Institute of Tibetology is introducing two years M.A. course in Buddhist Studies (English medium) with the affiliation of Sikkim University (SU), a Central University recognized by University Grants Commission (UGC). The M.A. degree certificate will be granted by Sikkim University.

Those desirous of pursuing the course may apply in a prescribed form and submit the application along with copies of required documents on or before 24th June, 2019.

Criteria:

The course is open to students who have completed graduation (Bachelors Degree) in Buddhist studies or in Science/Art or in allied subjects with English (written & spoken) as the medium. The 2 year course will begin from mid July 2019 for a limited number of students. Interested candidates who fulfil the following criteria may apply for admission:

A. Number of seats are as follows:

1. Total number of seats-15,
 - a) 60% of the seats will be reserved for Sikkim Subject students based on COI holders.

- b) Remaining seats will be available to the candidates from other parts of the country and the world.

B. Eligibility for admission:

- a) Graduate (Bachelors Degree) or its equivalent in any stream from any University or Institution/college recognized by Sikkim University (SU) or by the Government of Sikkim or the Government of India.
- b) The candidates should be well versed in English language (written & spoken).
- c) The local candidates are required to produce identification documents such as COI, SSC, voter card, Aadhaar card, Passport.
- d) The candidate coming from outside the State or from other countries must produce identification documents such as voter card or Aadhaar card or Passport/visa as may be applicable.
- e) Admission form can be obtained from the Namgyal Institute of Tibetology office or can be downloaded from the website – www.tibetology.net
- f) The last date for submission of the application is 24th June, 2019.
- g) Candidates may also submit their application online within 20th June, 2019.
