

ADMISSION ANNOUNCEMENT FOR 2019-20 ACADEMIC SESSION
BACHELOR OF SOWA RIGPA MEDICINE AND SURGERY (BSRMS) COURSE FOR
THE THIRD BATCH

Application in prescribed form is invited for the Bachelor of Sowa Rigpa Medicine and Surgery (BSRMS) course for the academic session 2019-20 being organised by the Namgyal Institute of Tibetology, Deorali – Gangtok, Sikkim (India). The aim is to produce graduates having profound knowledge of Sowa Rigpa to become qualified physicians and surgeons, to preserve and revive the unique system of nature based healing to benefit all mankind.

A. Qualifications required for admission:

- a) Minimum qualification class 12th standard pass preferably with science (Physics, Chemistry & Biology) or any other equivalent examination recognised by States/UTs and Central governments.
- b) For foreign students any other equivalent qualification from recognized/registered universities of their respective countries will be allowed.
- c) All candidates should be well versed in Tibetan grammar, composition, Buddhist philosophy. Those candidates who fail to meet the required standard in Tibetan language which includes grammar, literature and composition should be prepared to undergo one year preparatory course in Tibetan grammar, composition and literature before they become eligible to join the first year Sowa Rigpa course.

B. Other criteria for admission:

- d) Maximum age limit is 28 years.
- e) All candidates must produce identification documents such as voter card, Aadhaar card, Passport etc. In addition, local candidates must produce COI/SSC or such other legal documents to prove their local origin.
- f) Maximum of 6 seats out of 10 seats will be reserved for local candidates holding COI/SSC subject to their qualification in the admission test. In case they do not qualify, the seats will be made available to others to the extent of remaining vacancy.
- g) Admission form can be obtained from the Namgyal Institute of Tibetology office or can be downloaded from the website – www.tibetology.net

- h) The last date for submission of application is 10th June, 2019.
- i) The application should be accompanied by one time registration fee of Rs. 500 payable by demand draft (non refundable) in favour of Director, Namgyal Institute of Tibetology, Deorali – Gangtok (Sikkim) or the amount may be deposited through online transfer in the account indicated below.
- j) Security deposit of Rs. 1000 is required to be made by those who qualify for admission. This will be refunded on the basis of claim after graduation.

C. Candidates may also submit their application online within 4th June, 2019 with scanned copies of supporting documents.

Otherwise copies of self attested supporting documents should be submitted, where essential along with the application form. An entrance test will be conducted to select the candidates at the place and date indicated hereunder:

- a) Venue - Namgyal Institute of Tibetology.
- b) Date – 24st June 2019
- c) Time – 10:30 AM to 1:00 PM
- d) Subjects to be tested – Tibetan reading, speaking, writing (grammar, composition, letter writing etc.) and composition in English.

Candidates who qualify in the written test will be called for viva voce test at the Namgyal Institute of Tibetology.
